Respected Sir/Madam,

Based on your application and subsequent correspondence with the school / inspection of the school. I am Education Officer (Primary) Zilla Parishad Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar, **Vardan Foundation, Aurangabad Conducted, Chaitanya Valley International School, Karmad. Tq. Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar Dist. Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar English medium school** is recognized from **01-Apr-2025 to 31-Mar-2028** for the basic class of class 1st to 8th.

The above approval is subject to fulfilment of the following conditions.

1. The period of recognition shall not be extended and there shall be no obligation under any circumstances to grant recognition or affiliation after Class VIII.
2. The school shall comply with the provisions of the Children's Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Annexure One) and the Maharashtra Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 (Annexure Two).
3. The school shall admit children belonging to the nearest weaker sections and deprived groups, in the first grade, to the extent of at least 25% of the number of students in that grade and shall provide free and compulsory education to them till the completion of primary education. But further, this standard will be followed in the case of pre-primary classes also.
4. Paragraph 3 The school shall receive reimbursement in accordance with section 12(2) of the Act for children specified. A separate bank account will be provided to the school to receive such reimbursement.
5. The Institution / School shall not charge any capitation fee and shall not compel the children or their parents or guardians for any screening process.
6. No child shall be denied admission to school on account of lack of proof of age, religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of these.



7. (i) No child admitted to a school shall be retained in the same grade in which he belongs or expelled from the school until the completion of primary education. (ii) No child shall be subjected to corporal punishment or mental torture.  
(iii) No child shall be required to pass an examination with any Board until he has completed his Primary education.  
(iv) Every child who has completed primary education shall be given the certificate prescribed under rule 23.  
(v) Students with Disabilities / Special Needs will be included as per the provisions of the Act  
(vi) Appointment of teachers possessing the minimum qualification prescribed under section 23(1) of the Act; will be done. But further, teachers who do not hold the minimum qualification on the date of commencement of the Act shall acquire such minimum qualification within a period of 5 years.  
(vii) The teacher shall perform his/her duty specified in section 24 (1) of the Act, and (viii) the school shall ensure that the teacher/mistress does not engage herself in private tutoring. The school shall follow the syllabus prepared on the basis of the syllabus prescribed by the appropriate authority.
8. The school will follow the curriculum prepared on the basis of the curriculum prescribed by the appropriate authority.
9. The school shall admit students in proportion to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in Section 19 of the Act.
10. The school shall comply with the standards and norms specified in Section 19 of the Act. The facilities available at the time of the last inspection were as follows:

12. The school building or other structure or playground shall be used only for the purpose of education and skill development.
13. The school is being run by a body registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860) or the Bombay Public Trusts Act, 1950.
14. The school is not run for the benefit of any individual, group or association of individuals or any other person or for any profit.
15. The accounts of the school should be audited and certified by a chartered accountant and proper accounts should be prepared as per the rules. A copy of each account should be sent to the District Education Officer every year.
16. Please note that the accreditation code given to your school is (27190109226), which should be mentioned in any correspondence with this office.
17. The school shall submit such reports and information as the Director of Education/District Education Officer may request from time to time or shall comply with such instructions as the Government or




local authority may give to ensure the continued fulfilment of the conditions of recognition of the school or to rectify deficiencies in the functioning of the school.

18. Ensure that the organization's registration, if any, is renewed.
